as well heard on the music scene.

Today Annette is battling multiple sclerosis, a crippling disease of the central nervous system. She recently started The Annette Funicello Teddy Bear Company and is marketing her own fragrance, "Cello, by Annette." Last year, The Walt Disney Studios presented Annette with its Disney Legends Award, an award that recognizes individuals who have made a significant impact on the Disney Legacy.

"Annette: A Musical Reunion with America's Girl Next Door," is a tribute to this most popular Mouseketeer.

The record is made up of 47 songs, most of which are monotonous and tend to annoy the average listener. However, if you can make it through the first half of teeny-bopper 50s pop songs, the second half, made up of upbeat Hawaiian style music from Funicello's "Beach Party" and "Beach Blanket Bingo" films promises to be worth the wait.

Songs worth mentioning for their Caribbean beat are "Jamaica Ska," "Let's Twist Again," "Blame it on the Bosa Nova,"

"Surfer's Holiday" and a classic duet with the Beach Boys, "The Monkey's Uncle."

Another predominant style apparent on the album is the Funicello Italian sound.

Songs such as "Mia Cara, Mia Amore," "O Dio Mio" and "Italianette" are typical of the soft "Lady and the Tramp"-spaghetti-eating-scene-style, and are worth the listen.

Audiences will also be reminded of favorite childhood films with soundtrack recordings of Disney classics.

Soundtracks included on the album are "The Parent Trap," "Merlin Jones," from the "Misadventures of Merlin Jones," and the theme song from "Babes in Toyland."

In addition to the songs, the album includes candid conversations between Annette and Tutti Camarata, Disney's record producer, and rehearsals of recordings.

On one song, "Strummin' Song," Funicello loses her voice and can't finish the recording because of her laughing fit. This version has never before been released and adds a touch of humor to the album.

For the Disney collector, this album is a must-have, but keep your finger near the fast forward button, it may come in handy often.
