

- Must be a degree seeking student with 25 credit hours completed and reflected on SIMS (a passed course, which is repeated, cannot count as additional hours);
- 60 of your 95 credit hours must be in residence at Texas A&M University (will be waived if 2. your degree is posted on SIMS);
- 3. Must have a 2.0 cumulative GPR reflected on SIMS;
- Must be in good standing with the University, including no registration or transcript blocks for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc. 4.

Graduate Student Requirements:

You must receive your graduate degree from Texas A&M University to qualify to order a ring. If you do not graduate in December 1993, you must complete the following requirements, effective January 1, 1994, to be eligible to order a Ring:

- Must present an original "Letter of Completion" from the Office of Graduate Studies, which may not be obtained until you have completed all of your degree requirements (requires five (5) working days from the date of your request);
- Wait until after your degree is conferred and posted to your transcript;
- Must be in good standing with the Uhiversity, including no registration or transcript blocks for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc. 3.
