### **Engineer claims** IBM bosses made her have sex

SANTA MONICA, Calif. An IBM engineer is suing the computer company over her claim bosses forced her to have sex with a Pentagon official so IBM could get millions of dollars in government funding. Veronica Gunther, 35, alleged

superiors threatened to fire her in 1991 and 1992 unless she maintained a sexual relationship with Gary Denman, director of the Pentagon's Advanced Research Projects Agency, or ARPA. International Business Ma-

chines Corp. and two of Gunther's managers, Ray Blonn and Nancy Green, were named as de-fendants in the state court lawsuit filed Friday. It seeks unspecified damages

IBM spokesman Scott Brooks said the company doesn't com-

ment on pending litigation. ARPA spokeswoman Jan Walker also declined to comment. Efforts to locate Blonn, Green and Denman over the weekend for comment were unsuccessful.

Gunther has been on medical leave from the company since January, after twice attempting suicide while suffering from severe depression.

AFL-CIO President Lane Kirkland dismissed the notion that a loss would wound Clinton's presidency – a frequent argument by NAFTA supporters. "That is nonsense," Kirkland


said. "I think the best thing that could happen for the Clinton administration is for this agreement to be voted down.

Undecided lawmakers who dined with Clinton Sunday night told him there had been "a sea change out in their districts" and that public opinion is moving to-ward support, White House press secretary Dee Dee Myers said.

"We expect 'a Clinton land-slide" — it's going to be 218 votes, maybe 219, but that's all we need to win," Myers said.


