## Hearing-impaired out of touch about AIDS, health officials say

HOUSTON - There is no sign for AIDS yet among America's deaf, which shows just how out of touch the hearing-impaired community is about the deadly virus, officials say

In Houston, over a two-year period, 22 percent of the more than 500 deaf patients tested positive for HIV-infection at one clinic

"It's like they're five years behind," Scot Pott, director of the Montrose Clinic's Deaf Outreach Program, said through a sign language interpreter. "We still have people who think you can get AIDS from mosquitos

Pott said the Montrose Clinic had 67 grants rejected for its deaf outreach program because there were no statistics tracking AIDS in the deaf community at that time. The Centers for Disease Control in Atlanta still has no data on the percentages of AIDS in the deaf community.


