

considering a limit on the number of guns an individual may own and a broader version of a proposed ban on assault weapons.

Registering guns is not enough, Reno said, because people should be required "to know how to safely and lawfully use a gun" before they can buy one.

A task force from the U.S. Conference of Mayors presented Clinton with a report Thursday recommending gun registration, banning semiautomatic assault weapons, imposing waiting periods on purchases of all firearms, and significantly taxing ammunition and firearm sales. The frustrations of citizens




