

The man exaggerated the bene-fits of the Chronicle's "Extra Card," a legitimate offer, which provides discounts at area businesses

'He told me they were good at grocery stores and the bookstore on campus," Jasek said. "He said it was good at Winn Dixie and Kroger, but they hadn't heard about it, and another Chronicle salesman I ran into hadn't either.'

The man had signed all the receipts and apparently made no effort to hide what he was doing, Mc-Murrey said.
