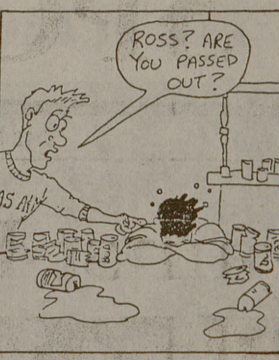

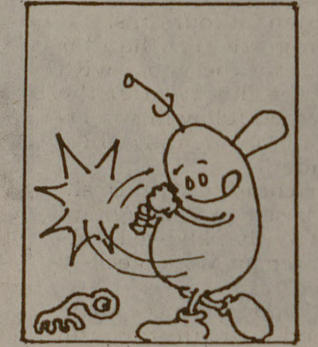

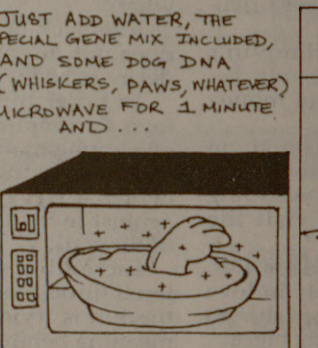

Richards sees money as motive for impending death of SWC

AUSTIN — Gov. Ann Richards, a Baylor University graduate, said Wednesday that she grew up thinking of Southwest Conference football as an immutable fact of life.

Now, it may go the way of other great institutions driven, she says, by money.

"When I was a kid growing up, there were certain truths and verities in life, and one was that Joe Louis was always going to be the world champion, that Franklin Roosevelt was always going to be president, that the Yankees were always going to win the pennant, and that there was no football except the Southwest Conference," Richards said.

"And so, in a sort of emotional way, I really am not happy at this circumstance."

But, she added of the potential SWC breakup, "In a practical way, this has been talked about so very long that it comes really as no shock to any of us."

Richards' alma mater is among four SWC schools — with the University of Texas, Texas A&M and Texas Tech — to receive invitations to join the Big Eight Conference.

Four other universities are being left behind: Texas

McDonald's asks customers not to light up in 1,400 restaurants

CHICAGO — McDonald's, the company that forswore America's love affair with fast food, bowed to the public's growing distaste for cigarettes and banned smoking Wednesday from its 1,400 company-owned U.S. restaurants.

A week after it was sued over the hazards of secondhand smoke, McDonald's Corp. also joined other chains in announcing support of federal legislation to ban smoking in all public places.

More than 3,600 of 9,100 McDonald's stores nationwide will be smoke-free. About 2,200 restaurants banned smoking last year, chain said.

The company urged its remaining franchisees to ban smoking. Another 253 stores in Canada also would be smoke-free under the ban.

Michael Hand, an associate professor of philosophy and humanities, said the administration is obviously not committed to shared governance.

"Gage does not have the moral authority to decide the curriculum for the College of Liberal Arts," Hand said. "This was obviously a political move."

Richard Street, a professor of speech communications and theatre arts, said the issue of faculty

governance is very important. "I feel like the shots are being called for us," Street said.

Gage said his decision was unique because there was also a University-wide proposal for a multicultural requirement recommended by the Faculty Senate.

"I will not set a precedent for deciding curriculum changes at the college level," Gage said.

The interim dean said he did not approve the College of Liberal Arts' original proposal because he is still looking at the Faculty Senate's proposal and he would prefer a University-

wide requirement over similar college-level curriculum.

Gage said he still has additional questions concerning the issue and he hopes to have a resolution by the end of the academic year.

In a memo to Jones last week, Gage said he would approve three hour requirement in international studies for the College of Liberal Arts if the council requested.

"As I have indicated, I will be responsive to their proposal," Gage said after Wednesday's decision.
