said. "Basically only the people from Texas know about the Corps. "Now everybody will get to know about our Corps and our traditions. Our biggest rivals - Baylor and Texas - are going with us. Rice, Texas Christian, Southern Methodist and Houston really didn't have it going against us." Junior Yell Leader Scott Torn said it would have been great if

the SWC had improved its credibility and tried to make the conference better for A&M, but said he was happy with the change. "Moving to the Big Eight allows A&M to enhance and showoff its football and athletic traditions," Torn said. "It will open the door for our basketball team to improve. "The games will be more exciting and the crowds will grow and be more excited. Aggies get bored watching us score, score and score on SWC schools. They don't have the same capability or

credibility as we do, so we have to move on. We are being dogged nationally for being in the SWC." Torn said he was sure Aggie traditions won't change because the decision goes through the Longhorns and A&M can continue their rivalry. "Our traditions are ingrained with Texas," he said. "As long as they go with us, we can continue our Thanksgiving bash and the rest of our rivalry. To those other schools in the SWC I say, thank you for everything, but we have to move on."
