Ross never lost that childhood interest in foreign policy. In the summer following her senior year in high school, Ross interned

in Washington, D.C., for Sugar Land Congressman Tom DeLay

While in D.C., Ross said she worked long hours at the Capitol doing everything from handling constituent mail to giving tours

of the building.

"I loved it," Ross said. "There is such an energy in the air. Everyone around you is involved in the government.

Toward the end of her internship, Ross said she was given the privilege of working on a bill for Congress. She said she began work by researching the bill, and after writing it, was required to call for co-signers.

"It was really cool because I was only 18 years old at the time," Ross said.

This experience helped Ross to see the differences between the U.S. and Malaysian governments more clearly, she said

From her personal experiences in Malaysia, Ross became aware of the strict censorship there. After once voicing her opinion

in school concerning the role of Malaysian women, Ross took a warning from her teacher.

"She told me that I had to stop

saying these things or my family would have to leave the coun-

try," Ross said. Ross soon realized that by voicing her opinion, she was merely imposing her American ideals on a completely different culture. These women were going to be third or fourth wives to men, she said. Ross was the one who needed to understand that this was the Malaysian culture.

Working internationally has become a goal for Ross because every day is a new experience, she said. Most companies would love to hire people who are willing to work internationally, Ross

"Even if you go abroad and it's not what you thought," Ross said, "you're going to make the best out of it and you can turn it into a learning experience.'




