SAN ANTONIO – A man has been charged with sexually assaulting a 32-year-old paralyzed nursing home resident who became pregnant and then lost the baby, authorities say

Dennis Paul Wallace, 39, was charged with sexual assault and released Sunday from Bexar County Jail after posting a \$25,000 bond.
