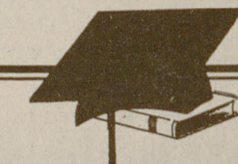

Technology will allow speeders to stay home

AUSTIN — Texas drivers who opt to take a defensive driving class to get a traffic ticket dismissed will soon be able to do so without leaving the comfort of home.

Two Houston entrepreneurs have teamed up with an Austin business to provide a method for taking the state-approved, six-hour course at home with the aid of videos and a minicomputer, both supplied by the company.

Inconvenience is a chief reason only 8 percent of Texas drivers who are ticketed take defensive driving courses, said Phil Ward, president of SA Training Co. of Austin, which provides its safety course to more than 250 schools across Texas.

Drivers who choose the take-home course have three days to complete it and may log on to the interactive computer system — via a toll-free phone line — at any hour. Another toll-free line has a live instructor on stand-by at all times to field questions from students.

Since mid-January, the take-home kits have been available only through two Houston outlets. More than 600 people have used them, said Scott Owens, one of the developers of the system. Ward said he believes all of the schools affiliated with USA Training — including several in Austin — will have the equipment by the end of the summer.

Owens said reaction from students has been positive, even though the \$40 course cost is more expensive than classroom instruction, which ranges from \$15 to \$30. The system includes a simple-to-use computer and videos that feature music by ZZ Top and James Brown and appearances by Jerry Seinfeld, Hulk Hogan and other celebrities. The videos feature comedian Jeff Altman.

"You mention to people a 'take-home defensive driving course,' and the light bulb goes off," he said. "They think: 'I can fast forward the video. I can have someone take the test for me.' But, hard as you might try, you can't beat the system."

Owens said safeguards were

built into the system to prevent the ticketed driver actually taking the course, and state requirement of state instruction is fulfilled.

"We have a pool of validation questions," said who formed US. Interbusiness partner Richard "When the students check equipment, they give us information about themselves; we access outside additional information from what they provided us, and we question that for validation."

One validation question, for example, is "What is your maiden name?" Owens said he hopes to divulge other questions their proprietary nature.

The Texas Education Commission, which certified the system last summer, put the take-home course through the ringer to make sure it could not be duped, said John B. Seaman, senior director of the State Office of Proprietary Schools, Education and Driver Training.

"We tested the validation questions by using our staff's own computer gurus," Seaman said. "We told them that they had to cheat."

Cheat they did, but "we caught every one of them," Owens said. Still, the system has its critics. The Driving School Association of Texas, a trade organization that represents about two-thirds of the state's 210 licensed operating schools, filed a lawsuit against TEA last year, challenging the certification process.

Scott Wilson, past president of the association, said he believes the system can be hoodwinked.

"There's still nothing stopping someone from having another person take it for them," he said. "You could be in the drinking a beer or watching a video while I'm taking the course. You. And whenever a question is asked, all you have to do is holler back to get the answer."

But Owens said the system who was supposed to be the test would need to be verified nearby to answer the verification questions, which are fired randomly.

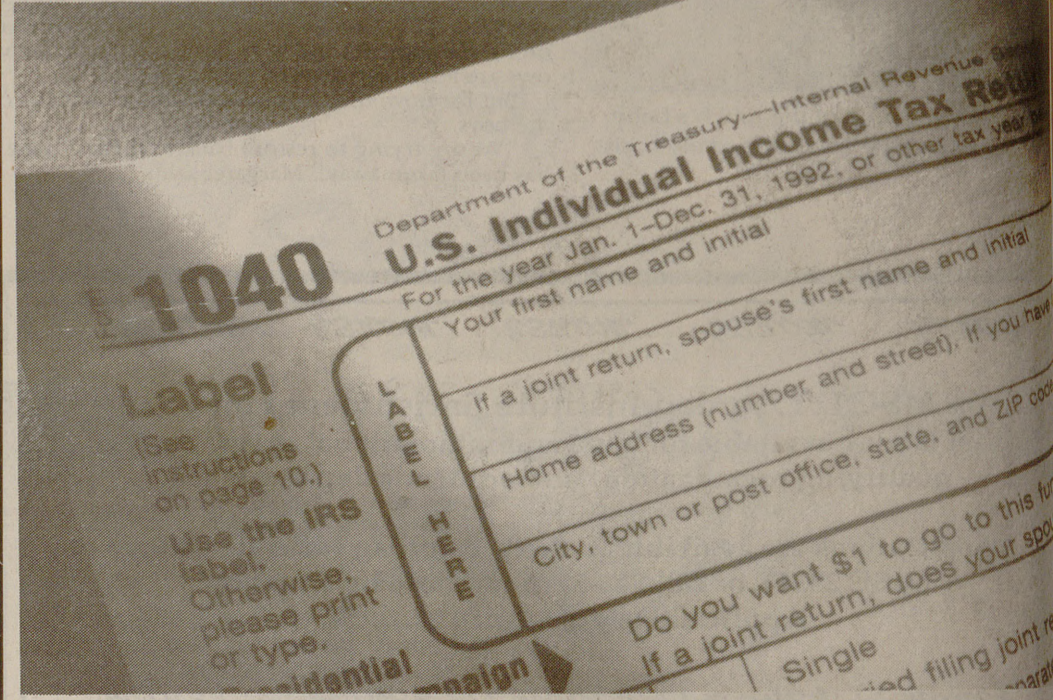
