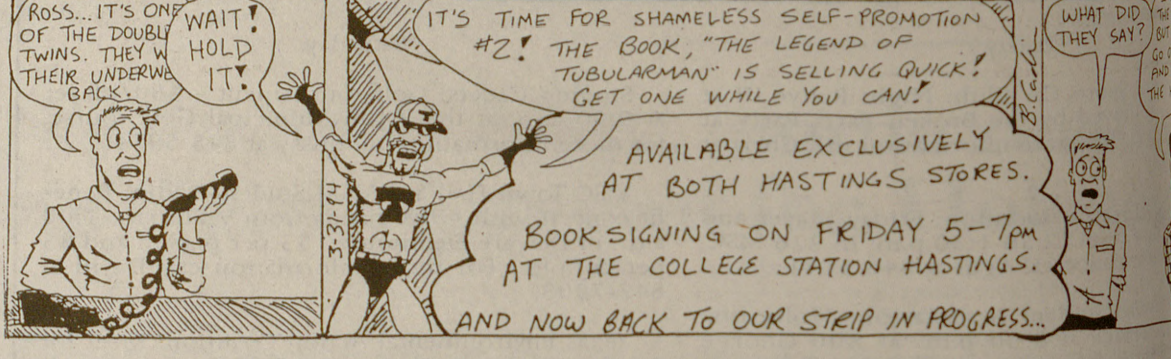

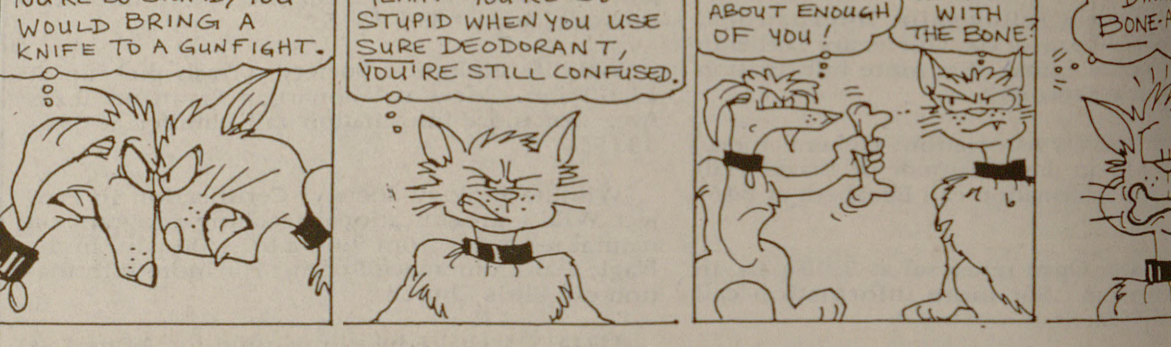

Undercover police wrong to pose as media at KKK rally, mayor says

INDIANAPOLIS — Undercover police were wrong to pose as news photographers at a Ku Klux Klan rally, Mayor Stephen Goldsmith said.
Two men, wearing false credentials identifying themselves as photographers for The Associated Press, were spotted by a legitimate photographer for the news service at the rally Saturday on the Statehouse steps.
The photographer, working as a stringer for the AP, asked the two men about the credentials and one said he was from "another office" of the AP. The photographer then saw Lloyd Jennings, superintendent of the Indiana State Police, at the rally and told him about the men.
Jennings approached the two and said they told him they were undercover Indianapolis officers. On Monday, the news service sent a letter of protest to Police Chief James D. Toler.
"The practice of officers identifying themselves as news reporters threatens the public's trust in the police," said Robert Shaw, Indiana bureau chief. "The police does it damage journalism's credibility, it's simply wrong."
Toler was on vacation this week, Goldsmith, who received a copy of the AP's letter, said police were wrong to pose as AP photographers and would no longer do so.
