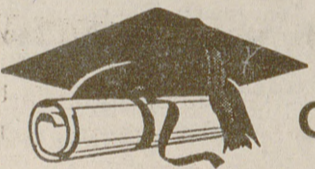

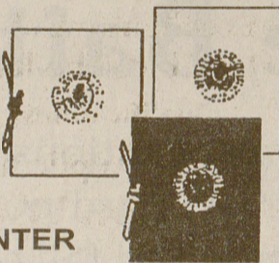

Gina Perez (No. 17) tags an unidentified St. Edward's University player during Friday's doubleheader. The No. 9-ranked Lady Aggies won both series against Sam Houston State University and St. Edward's University during the weekend.

A&M won Friday's doubleheader, 5-3 and 6-2. Kim Gonzalez was credited with Friday's first win against the LadyKats (12-29). Gonzalez went seven innings, allowing two earned runs. She improved her record to 23-9.

Cristy Bunting improved her record to 13-7 by throwing a three-hitter during her seven inning stint. Bunting had four strike outs.

The Lady Aggies then faced St. Edward's during Saturday's doubleheader. Kim Gonzalez gained her second victory in as many days as she threw no-hit ball for four innings, striking out three. Bunting relieved Gonzalez, allowing only one hit to 13-11 St. Edward's. Beth Gerken had the game-winning hit as A&M rolled to a 4-0 victory.

A&M crushed St. Edward's, 9-1, in Saturday's nightcap as Bunting earned her third save of the season.

The Lady Aggies improved to 42-16 during the weekend and will face Southwest Texas State University on Tuesday at 5 p.m.

Olazabal seizes Master's victory with flawless golf

AUGUSTA, Ga. — The Masters. Another foreign champion. A player of enormous talent finally realizing unfulfilled promise.

The story line held up. Just substitute the name Jose Maria Olazabal for Greg Norman.

This was to be the Masters that Norman finally won, but it became the major Olazabal finally won. The Spaniard stumbled over the last two holes, but so did Tom Lehman and Larry Mize.

Olazabal's solid closing round of 69 on Sunday gave him 279 for 72 holes, two strokes ahead of Lehman and three ahead of Mize, the winner here in 1987.

Playing in the same group with Lehman and just behind Mize, Olazabal scrambled when he had to, tamed the tricky Augusta greens and never cracked in the pressure down the stretch. He didn't make a bogey until he hit a poor chip on the 17th.

Olazabal all but closed it out by rolling in a 40-foot eagle putt on the par-5 15th after his second shot just barely cleared the water and didn't roll back into the pond as others had all week.

the Relays hungry for preference."

Garvin, who placed third on Thursday night in the invitational 1,500-meter race, couldn't catch the event's runner from SMU, but ran well enough in the races to receive consideration as the leading contender for the SWC men's 1,500-mile.

"The relay race did establish Scott as the best 1,500-meter runner in the conference."

Marcinkiewicz. "Right now I don't think there is a candidate in the state that can beat Scott in the 1,500."

Another solid performance for the Aggies occurred in the pole vault where Mark Mullins scored 17-0 and 3/4 to take second in the in the event.

Curt Young in what he called "a confidence building race" took second place in the university division of the men's 110-meter hurdles with a time of 14.07. Freshman Larry Wade, who is the fastest qualifying time in the preliminaries finished a disappointing seventh.

"We came here to get ready for the Southwest Conference meet and we did that," Head track coach Nelson said.

The highlight of the meet came when the Santa Monica Track Club (Mike Mann, Leroy Burrell, Floyd Heard and Carl Lewis) won the invitational 4x100-meter relay setting a stadium and a meet record with their time of 37.89. Heard, A&M's former collegiate 200-meter record holder, was happy to come back to Texas and to so well.

The Aggies will run next weekend in College Station at the Texas A&M relays taking their final step before the SWC meet.
