

### Bats find new home in S.A. high school

SAN ANTONIO — About 50 Mexican free-tail bats made themselves at home in a wing of Roosevelt High School on Monday, so about 700 students moved out.

Many of the unwanted hangers-on were clustered in twos and threes on the ceiling. Others were napping in the upper corners of a stairwell.

The invaded wing will remain closed until all the bats have been evicted. The students moved to the auditorium and cafeteria to hold classes

Tim Hanks, owner of Commercial Bat Control, told the school that releasing the bats is preferable to killing them since their bodies would create an

offensive odor and pose a possible health hazard. "They're basically very harmless," he said. "Oth-erwise, I wouldn't be in this business. I've been bitten several times, but the bats have very small teeth.' Custodians removed most of the bats, include




