The gold medal will be given annually to a scientist who has made important contributions in any area of chemistry.

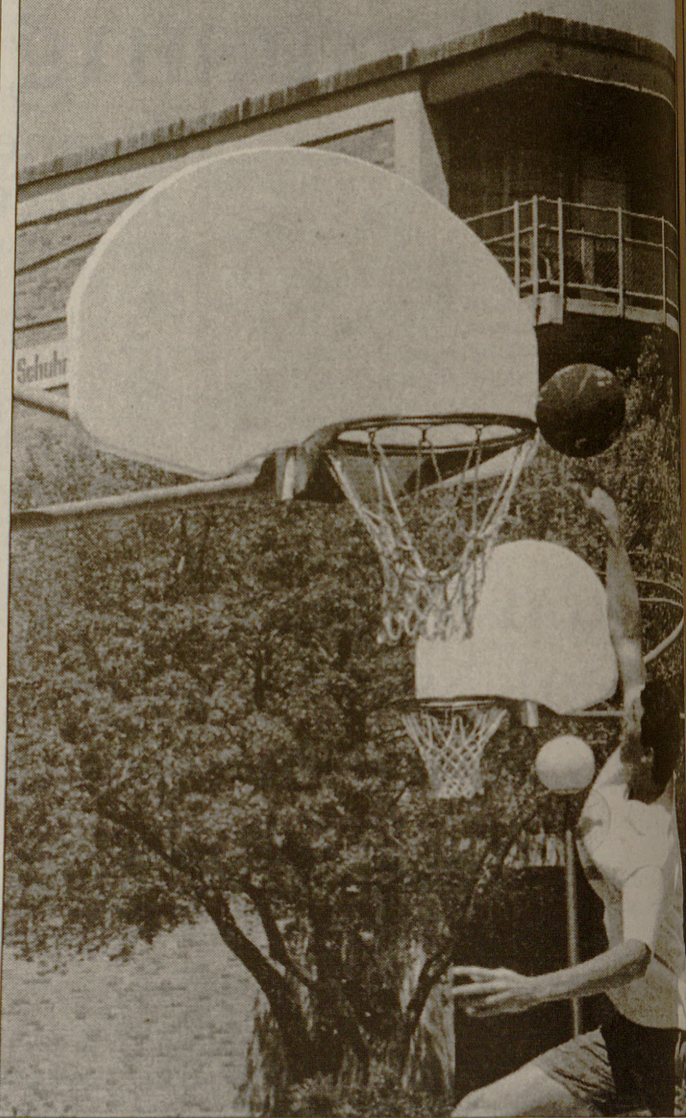
Health center to offer cash prizes for best recipes


