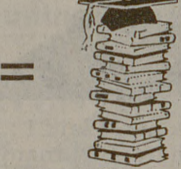

"As the college grew," Gerling said, "they put up what was known as the actual station."

Schultz said the process of bringing a historical marker to the site started about 12 months ago and involved a great deal of time and research.

"The local commission looks over the application and then sends it to Austin," he said.

"If they approve it, the landowner then has to pay for the marker."

The price for the marker is set by a firm in San Antonio, which has a contract for the foundry work.

the railroad depot is costing the city of College Station \$750.

Halter said a drawing of the depot, sketched several years ago, has helped to pay for local historical markers.

"Jim Gaston drew a sketch based on old photographs of the station,"

Halter said. "The city made reproductions of the drawing to sell and the funds went to paying for historic preservation."

The original drawing is located in the city's library.

Halter said he is excited about the dedication of the marker for the train depot because the recognition of its historical importance is long overdue.

"This is the sixth historical marker in the city, and it probably should have been the first," he said.

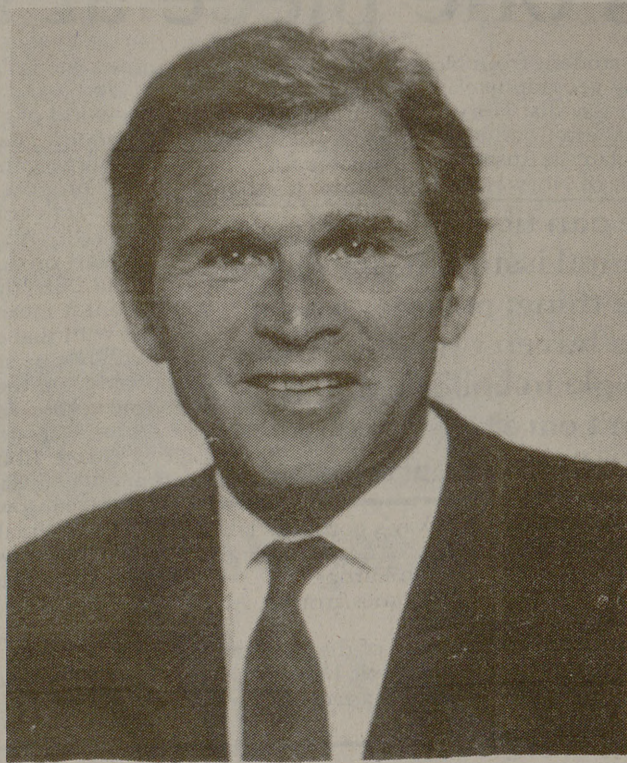
