Guard officers suspected of spilling secrets to ex-colonel

CORPUS CHRISTI — After the Texas National Guard suggested the military investigate three officers who allowed a colonel access to classified military information after he was linked to drug smuggling...

The Corpus Christi Caller-Times said it obtained documents in which the officers concluded that the colonel, Richard Brito, should be granted jury-type investigations. Brito remained in a semi-military position after his clearance was stripped from him in 1992 because of the drug investigations, the newspaper said.

An internal Guard investigation into the matter concluded late 1993. The Guard's legal review has been released to the public. The Caller-Times said it has obtained thousands of Guard documents, including the legal review, transcripts from the internal investigation supporting documentation.

Three top Guard officers initially denied that Brito's clearance was suspended on March 10, 1992, according to a five-page review. The officers are Col. Robert Kohler, former chief of staff; Dwan James, former director of personnel; and Lt. Col. Robert Cottle, director of plans, operations and training.

Guard officials said Saturday Major Gen. Sam Turk, adjutant general of Texas, has discharged Brito from the state militia because of concern over his alleged involvement in drug trafficking. Brito, who has denied wrongdoing, has been the subject of several investigations and is under five-count perjury indictment in Grimes County.

Brito served as director of operations and training until he was indicted in September 1993. He was an environmental specialist when he was discharged.

Clinton took shots at press during media banquet

WASHINGTON — To hear President Clinton tell it, he wanted to tackle Whitewater head on, "but couldn't find the right canoe." Jabbing at the press and joking about himself, Clinton provided the humor Saturday night at the 80th annual White House Correspondents Dinner.

Clinton said he concluded there was no deliberate conspiracy by reporters to distort and exaggerate his role in the Whitewater affair. "You can't help yourselves, it's just a matter of pure instinct," he said.

Clinton said Whitewater, which involved an Arkansas land investment he and his wife made 10 years ago, taught him valuable lessons that also served as advice to the press corps. "Do not borrow money. Do not lend money. Do not make money. And for goodness sake, do not lose money."

His jokes covered the journalistic lot. The Wall Street Journal, he criticized first lady Hillary Rodham Clinton for turning a \$1,000 investment in the commodity market into a \$98,000 profit.

"For the Wall Street Journal to criticize my wife for making money is like Field and Stream criticizing someone for catching a fish," he said.

He also said that instead of blaming the press for trying to sink his presidency in scandal, he would turn over a new leaf and try to help reporters do their jobs. "I need to help you get through slow news days," he said. "So I will leak you details of potential scandals." These include "the seeds of grapes I've eaten in super markets" and "the discrepancy between my actual weight and the weight on my drivers' license."

Clinton recently raised eyebrows for admitting that he was briefs instead of boxer shorts. He said that in the interests of full disclosure, "I am taking the opportunity to make copies of my briefs available to the news media."

"The originals, he said, "have been turned over to the special counsel" investigating Whitewater. During the banquet, the association also presented its annual journalism awards.
