Dallas proposes employee coverage for gay couples

DALLAS — The City Council heard a plan Monday to extend employee insurance coverage to workers' same-sex domestic partners.

Homosexual couples are not explicitly addressed in the proposal. However, it would apply to gay and lesbian partnerships, said Cliff Heley, first assistant city manager.

Common-law spouses of city workers already qualify for benefits. "All we're doing is informing the council of the nature of other jurisdictions," Heley said before a budget workshop, which council members were briefed on the proposal.

The Dallas proposal is part of a plan recently passed in Austin.

Like the Austin plan, the Dallas proposal would define a domestic partner as "an individual who lives in the same household and shares the common resources of life—close, personal, intimate relationship with a city employee."

However, opponents of Austin plan gathered more than 15,000 signatures to place a proposed charter revision on the municipal ballot to restrict benefits to legally married couples and their children.

The Dallas ordinance would require a written declaration of a domestic partnership.

Gary Buffington, 1994-95 special board chair and a member of the new committee, said each member of the group will have a say.

"We've been asked to examine the election regulations as they are written now," Buffington said. "Each member has been asked to make two recommendations of what should be changed."

Buffington said he is pleased with the make-up of the group. "We've got good members, good representation from across the campus," he said.

Wilson said the group will meet Tuesday evening to present their individual views on necessary changes and will meet from there.

"We are pretty much looking at striking out the old regulations and writing a new set," Wilson said. "It would almost be easier to rewrite them than to try to change them."

The recommendations of the group will be presented to the Chris McNeely, chair of the Student Senate's Rules and Regulations Committee, and to 1994-95 Election Commissioner Charles Ferguson.

Wilson said the Senate will be the final say in any changes in the regulations.

"This committee is not going to have binding authority," Wilson said. "We are only going to make recommendations."

Wilson said the work being done should help prevent future problems.

"This is something that definitely needs to be done," Wilson said. "In the past, there would just be a ruling by the judicial board and no changes would be made. This created some of the loopholes."
