If you don't have an account, you can access Gopher from the computers in most of the microcomputer labs on campus. If you have a computer that is connected to the campu network via Ethernet, you can install the Gopher software on your machine.

Once you've accessed Gopher, a list of menu options appears. You can choose menu items until you come across appropriate information, or you can us (the Gopher search engine) to do a local or world with search for any word or combination of words.
