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Tanning is free.

Location: Jay's has a very good location. The gym is on Old College Road just off of South College, making it easily accessible for Bryan and College Station residents.

Lifestyles

Cleanliness: Lifestyles is very clean. The facilities are roomy and well organized, making the

overall appearance very appealing.

Friendliness: The staff at Lifestyles is very friendly.

Extras: Lifestyles offers free trainers and body fat ratio testing. They also have the Keiser pneumatic resistance machines which use air compression resistance instead of weights. Tanning is extra, but the whirlpool is included.

Location: Lifestyles has two locations, but Lifestyles II in Bryan is for women only. The other location is on Harvey Road in the Woodstone shopping center. Bryan residents can expect a ten to fifteen minute drive.

If weight training is a priority then Lifestyles, Gold's or Jay's would be the best bet. AeroFit has recently upgraded their free weights and nautilus machines, but they still don't compare to the other three which have more

than 8,000 pounds of free weights each.

AeroFit offers tennis courts and a pool, and Lifestyles and AeroFit both have racquetball facilities.

"We only have one (racquetball) court now because we wanted to make more room for aerobics," Jami Campbell of Lifestyles said.

"Now we have the largest aerobics room in Bryan/College Station."

Lifestyles also has a private aerobics corner for beginners or anyone feeling too conspicuous on the floor.

Aerobics classes are offered at each gym but Gold's, Lifestyles and AeroFit offer the most and reportedly best classes. AeroFit even has an Aer-

obics facility located just south of Target on Texas Avenue.

"There are some good facilities in this area," Kinesiology Graduate Assistant Terry Coker said. "Just be careful who you listen to, especially when training with weights."

Coker said there is no guarantee trainers in gyms know what they are doing.

If they are certified or have a degree in kinesiology Coker thinks they probably know what they are doing.

"The safest thing to do," Coker said, "is find a trainer with certification through the American College of Sports Medicine or the National Strength and Conditioning Association."

The Texas A&M Gopher

In early 1992, a new creature began burrowing its way around Texas A&M. This friendly critter, called Gopher, helps you browse many of the resources on the local campus network or on the worldwide Internet. Texas A&M's Gopher provides easy access to endless amounts of information. You can use Gopher to do such things as:

- Find out what University events are happening on any given day.
- Look up faculty, student or staff phone numbers, electronic mail addresses and office locations.
- View current and archived issues of campus newsletters such as the *Fortnightly*, *System News*, *Computing News*.
- Access NOTIS, FirstSearch, TEXSearch and the Evans Library Archives.
- Check out current campus employment opportunities and job descriptions.
- Read up on computer resource information.
- See what the local and national weather forecasts and current conditions are.

Pick up a quote from Paradise Lost for a term paper.

- Read city council meeting minutes from Wellington, New Zealand.
- Listen to the final U.S. Presidential Debate of 1992.
- Read about the Human Genome Project.
- Learn about federal grants.
- Download public domain software.

These examples are a tiny sampling of the information Gopher can deliver. The fantastic thing about Gopher is that you don't need to be a computer geek to use it. Gopher is easy to access and easy to use. If you have a VM, Open VMS/VAX or UNIX account, after logging on to type Gopher to access Gopher's main menu. If you're a student, and you don't have an account, use ACCESS to create one. (Call 845-4217 for information.)

If you don't have an account, you can access Gopher from the computers in most of the microcomputer labs on campus. If you have a computer that is connected to the campus network via Ethernet, you can install the Gopher software on your machine.

Once you've accessed Gopher, a list of menu options appears. You can choose menu items until you come across the appropriate information, or you can use VERONICA (the Gopher search engine) to do a local or world wide search for any word or combination of words.

Because Gopher is a tool used on the Internet at thousands of other locations, the amount of information available is unbelievable. Besides information pertaining to a particular geographical area, Gopher servers also specialize in medicine, science, commerce, government, entertainment and other special interests. Gopher servers deliver text, index searches, still images, audio, public domain software all over the world.

With Gopher, you can:

- Learn what earthquakes took place yesterday.
- Read today's student newspaper from a school 2,000 miles away.
