should not be so quick to "rag" on CampTexas.

"We started small, too," he said.

"There were only seven people at the first (Fish) camp." Cole said instead of pointing out CampTexas' perceived drawbacks, A&M students should be proud Fish Camp is so highly regarded.

"I think other schools calling shows how much other places respect the Fish Camp program," he said.

The fact that Fish Camp is completely student-run is what makes it unique and special, Knox said.

"It is done by students who care," he said.

"These students aren't paid anything to be a counselor. Actually, they pay to go to camp. They go because they want to pass the Aggie Spirit along."

Tim Sweeney, an associate director of student activities, said he has never seen anything like Fish Camp at any school as large as Texas A&M.

"The fact that it is organized, financed and entirely run by students as opposed to administrative student orientations at other universities makes it unique," he said.

"You just don't get this from other schools."

development specialist for the Human Resources Department and GED instructor, said the program was opened campus-wide to serve more people.

"Since the program is opened campus-wide, it serves quite a diverse population of people," she said. "We would like to see

our personnel accomplish whatever goals they have set for themselves."

Voelkel said the Physical Plant has great success with the programs.

"Since 1986, 100 Physical Plant employees have received their GED certificate," he said. "Currently we have 12 enrolled in the GED program, 12 in the ABE program and 18 in the ESL program."

Voelkel said the programs are a "win-win" situation.

"The employee benefits by gaining skills to progress," he

said "and the employer benefits by workers having an increased skill level and better understanding of total quality management and various technical programs."

Voelkel said sometimes the department loses some of the more ambitious workers when the employees gain their GED.

"After participating in the programs, many of our employees become qualified for better jobs or entrance to junior colleges," he said, "but this makes us happy to know that we are able to help someone better themselves."
