that Ensminger first faced off against his alma mater, as his Bulldogs cruising to a 31-10 triumph over the Tigers at Athens.

It was also at Georgia that Ensminger's offensive system became nationally known. In 1992, the Bulldogs averaged 32 points a game, with tailback Garrison Hearst placing third in the Heisman Trophy balloting while winning the Doak Walker award, an honor Aggie senior tailback Rodney Thomas is nominated for this season.

Another star of Ensminger's system is Georgia's senior quarterback Eric Zeier, who already holds 61 school and 11 Southeast Conference passing records.

Ensminger's offensive strategy revolves around making opposing defenses respect the run and the pass on every single down. Despite the increased aerial attack this system suggests, Thomas said the system is not all that different from the one that Aggie fans are

used to seeing.

"I think the offense is fairly the same in that it will allow the running backs make big plays," Thomas said. "I think it's going to be a good offense and showcase a lot of guys."

In Saturday's game, Ensminger will match-up against an old coach in Lynn Amedee, LSU's offensive coordinator.

"Lynn and I have been good friends ever since I've been through playing," Ensminger said. "He doesn't like to lose, he didn't when I played for him at LSU and he still doesn't."

Amedee held the position of offensive coordinator for the Aggies from 1985-87, and under him, A&M became the first SWC team to average over 200 rushing and passing yards in the same season. Ensminger said Amedee helped him make up his mind and come to A&M.

"We spoke about (jobs) and leaving Georgia, and I asked, 'What about A&M?'" Ensminger said. "He said, 'I'd jump at it, it was a great tradition, a great program and it's the type of atmosphere you'd like to be in.'"



Hockey camps to open today

NEW YORK (AP) — Starting today, the Winnipeg Jets will open training camp. And by next week, all 26 NHL teams practice.

That's good news to the players, who were expecting a possible lockout on Monday. And good news to NHL Players Association director Bob Goodenow, who expects to negotiate the NHL in an effort to work out a new collective bargaining agreement.

"What this means is that the camps will go forward as planned and the negotiation process between the parties will also continue," Goodenow said Wednesday in a prepared release after he learned that the NHL had told teams that training camps would open on time.

Teams received a fax from the league Wednesday that said in part: "You can confirm to the press that all camps will be open."

Arthur Pincus, NHL vice president of public relations, said the faxes were sent "just to clarify all the speculation about the training camps."

That had been a big topic of interest ever since Dallas Morning News reported on Tuesday that said NHL commissioner Gary Bettman would order a lockout of camp if no contract agreement was reached by then.

"We never closed them down," Pincus said Wednesday. "As I've said all along, we're operating business as usual."

"I think our winning streak at the end of the year taught a lot of guys what it takes to win," Tiger flanker Eddie Kennison said. "We expect A&M to be just as tough as they have been in the past."

LSU returns six starters on offense and six players on defense from last season. Safety Ivory

Hilliard is an All-American candidate while Kennison ranked among the nation's leaders in punt returns and kickoff returns.

Offensive coordinator Steve Ensminger said the Tigers will be better than they were last season.

"They have a chance to be a really good football team," Ensminger said. "There going to be better defensively, and anytime you can beat a team like Alabama, you can beat anybody."
