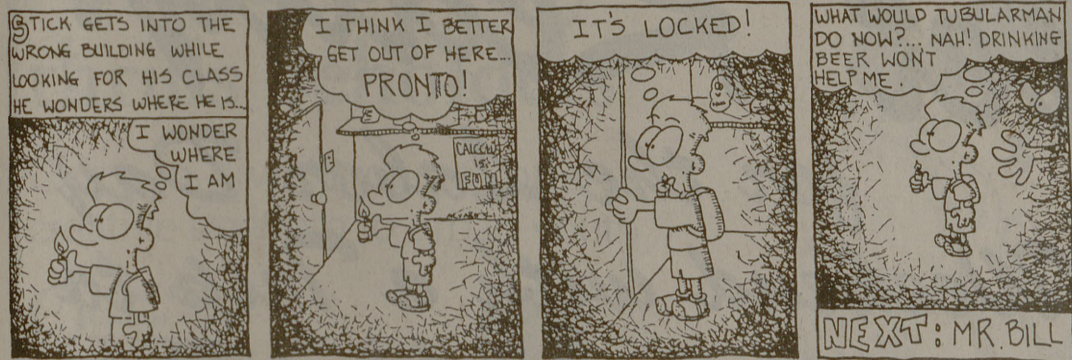

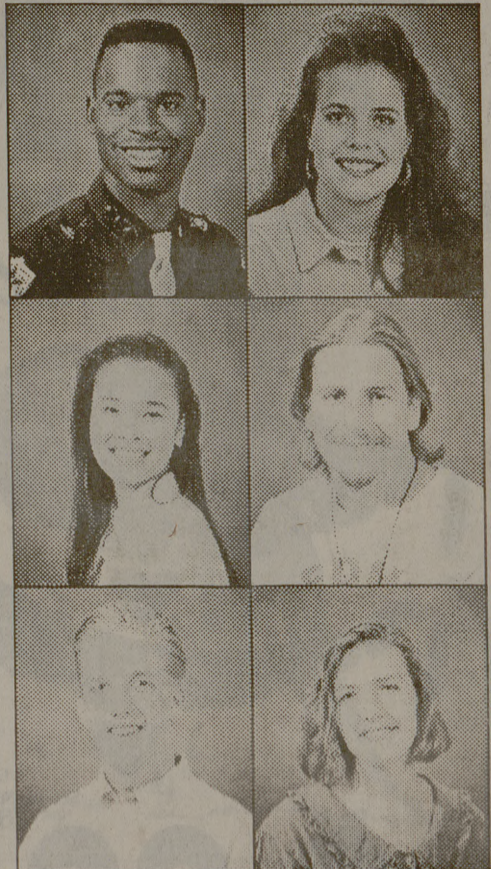

Boenig has been involved with A&M's Student Government since his second semester here and has previously held the positions of academic affairs chair and speaker pro tempore. "When I first got involved with Student Government, I wasn't really sure why I did it," he said. "Then I started seeing that I fit in and that I could make a difference."
