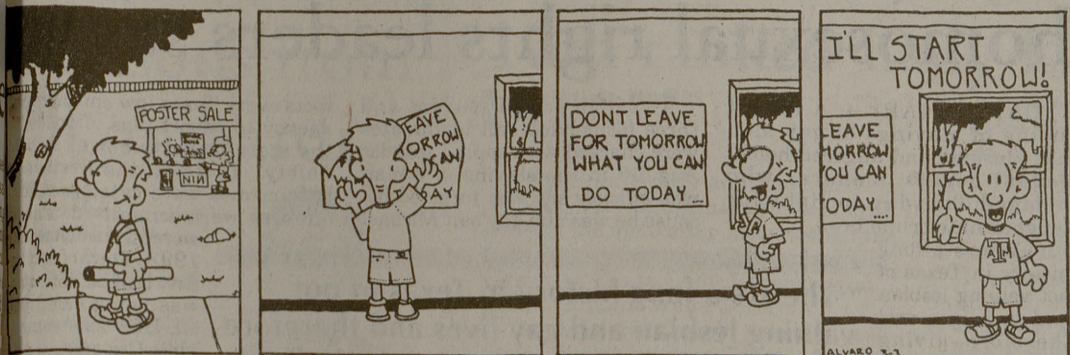

The majority of on-campus interviews are granted to students after the companies have screened the students' resumes. The interviews are then held in the Career Center.

Another service the Career Center offers is in the cooperative education program.

Pat White, assistant director in the cooperative education program, said the program is a multiple-work experience program.

"The student goes to orientation with the co-op office and then registers with a disk," White said.

"Usually, the student alternates work and school," she said.

In the co-op program, students alternate between working one semester and attending school. Students usually work for three terms, White said.

"Students usually see the company through one year of operation," White said.

"It is like a good, year-long interview with the company," she said.

White said there are generally more students from the technical, engineering areas in the co-op program. However, the co-op program also provides opportunities for other majors, such as liberal arts, White said.

"The co-op program provides a wonderful opportunity for students," she said.

"There is a definite advantage to students who get work experience," White commented.

Turner said the improving economy has helped students find jobs.

"Last year, we coordinated almost 8,000 interviews, an 8 percent increase over last year," Turner said.

"We had a 6 percent increase on our number of employers, and we were the only large office in the nation with an increase," Turner said.

Undergraduate Student Requirements:

- You must be a degree seeking student and have a total of 95 credit hours reflected on the Texas A&M University Student Information Management System. (A passed course, which is repeated and passed, cannot count as additional credit hours.)
- 30 credit hours must have been completed in residence at Texas A&M University. If you did not successfully complete one semester at Texas A&M University prior to January 1, 1994, you will need to complete a minimum of 60 credit hours in residence. (This requirement will be waived if your degree is conferred and posted with less than 60 A&M hours.)
- You must have a 2.0 cumulative GPR at Texas A&M University.
- You must be in good standing with the University, including no registration or transcript blocks for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc.

Graduate Student Requirements:

If you are a December 1994 degree candidate and you do not have an Aggie ring from a prior degree year, you may place an order for a '94 ring after you meet the following requirements:

- Your degree is conferred and posted on the Texas A&M University Student Information Management System; and
- You are in good standing with the University, including no registration or transcript blocks for past due fees, loans, parking tickets, returned checks, etc.

If you have complete all of your degree requirements prior to September 16, 1994, you may request a "Letter of Completion" from the Office of Graduate Studies and present it to the Ring Office in lieu of your degree being posted.

Procedure To Order A Ring:

- If you meet the above requirements, you must visit the Ring Office no later than Wednesday, September 21, 1994, to complete the application for eligibility verification (requires several days to process).
- If your application is approved and you wish to receive your ring on approximately November 16, 1994, you must return and pay in full by cash, check, money order, Visa or Mastercard no later than September 23, 1994.

HOW TO HOOK INTO CABLE RADIO

- One short length of black coaxial cable
- One cable splitter (one input splitter, two outputs)
- One 75-300 ohm transformer
