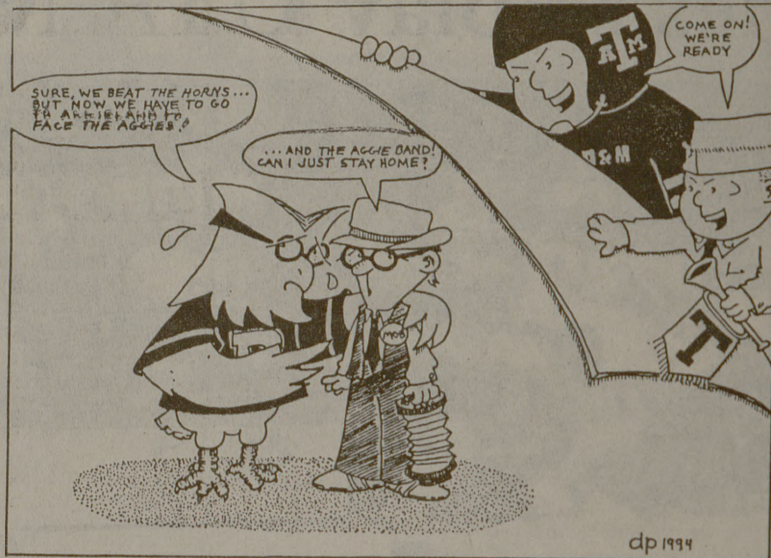

Computing and Information Services, said the best defense against unauthorized use of an E-Mail account is to choose a password that is difficult to break.

"Most people use their name spelled backwards or their dog's name," Kemper said. "Instead, choose a combination of words. Use 'dogtorun' and put a number in the middle. That renders it very hard to run against an encrypted dictionary. Second, never, ever, share your password with anybody."

Blount said breaking into his account to send racist messages was digital terrorism.

"It's no different than a burglar coming into your house," Blount said. "Then, 20,000 people minding their own business got attacked."

"If they want to be neo-Nazis or fascists or racists, that's their business, but don't hide behind the cloak of Texas A&M. Throw your shoulders back and stand up for it."

bombers: Israeli soldiers and security forces will find you sooner or later, and your fate will be bitter," Rabin said.

The government authorized more money for Shin Bet, the internal security service, charging it with a concerted effort to locate cells of the fundamentalist Hamas movement which claimed responsibility for the attacks.

It ordered the arrest of suspected militants and the use of "more efficient" interrogations, in

the words of one official.

"We need to use other methods, which it's best not to talk about," said Housing Minister Binyamin Ben-Eliezer.

Israeli and Western human rights groups have accused Israeli security forces of torturing Palestinian prisoners. Israel has denied the charges.

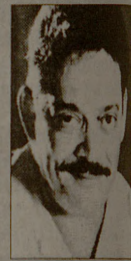
Police Minister Moshe Shahal said the government also planned "an international campaign" to cut off donations to Hamas from the United States, Britain, Iran and other countries. Shahal said American charities for Hamas were centered in Chicago and Texas.

## Raul Julia suffers stroke, slips into coma

NEW YORK (AP) — Actor Raul Julia slipped into a coma Thursday, four days after he suffered a stroke, his agent said.

Julia, the versatile star of films from "Kiss of the Spider Woman" to "The Addams Family," remained in an unidentified Manhattan hospital, agent Jeff Hunter said.

The 54-year-old took a turn for the worse after his condition was listed as guarded a day earlier, Hunter said in a statement issued by Cynthia Parsons of the William Morris Agency.

On Tuesday, the agent had said doctors were optimistic about the actor's recovery.

Julia's greatest Hollywood success has been opposite other actors — particularly his role as a South American political prisoner in "Kiss of the Spider Woman." William Hurt won the 1985 Academy Award for best actor for his role in the film.

Julia's other co-starring credits include appearances with Richard Dreyfuss in "Moon Over Parador," Harrison Ford in "Presumed Innocent," Clint Eastwood in "The Rookie" and Robert Redford in "Havana."

Julia's first prominent roles came at Joseph Papp's New York Shakespeare Festival in the late 1960s. He earned Tony Award nominations for his roles on Broadway in "Nine," "Threepenny Opera," "Where's Charley?" and "Two Gentlemen of Verona."

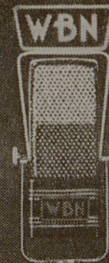
