university committees chair. "The rules and regulations and student services committee members have not been chosen," Holland said. Holland said that they will begin by digging back into the Senate's legislature. They will probably come up

with 20 or 30 issues to work on. "Hopefully, we won't find that many," he said. "We will pick out a half dozen or so to work on." He said the committee will then work to implement the new legislation. "The committee members know the different administrators that they deal with about current issues," Holland said. "I'll send them to talk with

the administrators." Jones said they will take the same steps of bringing original bills to the administration. "We will bring up the bills and make sure they are still current and then take them to the administration," he said. Holland said as committee chair, he will be setting the meeting times and he, along with Leslie, created the seating. "I usually run a committee

where I don't have anymore say than anyone else does," he said. "I don't have any special pull in these committees." Leslie said part of her platform was to work to secure the legislation of the Senate. "The constitution says part of my job is to make sure the legislation is followed up on," she said. "But that is not always possible because I have so many other things to do."
