booted the extra point, the Aggies had a 21-0 lead, and the Longhorns looked beat.

"When we were up 14, and then got that fumble, I was pretty sure we were going to win," Armstrong said. "Down on the ground, I was just smiling away when I saw Brandon running. Nobody was gonna catch him, because Brown was the fastest guy on the field and he was laying on the ground."

Although the Longhorns ended up gaining more yards than the Aggies, every big play and big break seemed to come the Aggies' way. On their first drive of the game, on a second- and-16 play, junior quarterback Corey Pullig stunned the Longhorn defense by going up top and hitting senior flanker Brian Mitchell downfield for a 52-yard gain.

Five plays later, on a third- and-five from the UT 15, Pullig hit Thomas, who looked like the second-coming of Carl Lewis as he hurled himself airborne from about the six-yard line into the end zone for the first score of the game.

The Aggies' second drive belonged to sophomore tailback

Leeland McElroy, who accounted for 46 of A&M's 70 yards on the drive, and scored the Aggies' second touchdown, to make the score 14-0. In the second half, UT placekicker Phil Dawson made the almost always fatal mistake when, after UT's only touchdown, he kicked off to McElroy.

Eighty-three yards later, the Aggies had a first-and-goal at the Texas one-yard line, and three plays after that, the Aggies had their 24 point lead back at 31-7.

"We switched Leeland and Billy (Mitchell) right before the kick, but I was still very surprised that they kicked to him," head coach R.C. Slocum said. "It was a big play. We got breaks and a good turnover, but it wasn't easy out there."

While admitting that everyone on the team was hyped up for the annual clash with Texas, he hinted at concern for the team's focus in relation to the remaining two games.
