Aggie swim team scores upset victory over U.T.

The 24th ranked Texas A&M women's swimming and diving team upset the No. 2 Texas Lady Longhorns 177-123 Tuesday at the P.L. Downs Natatorium. The Aggies, who ran their dual meet record to 2-0, gave coach Mel Nash his first victory over the Longhorns in 16 seasons at the helm.

Rockets pull out win in final seconds

CLEVELAND (AP) — Ha-keem Olajuwon became the leading scorer in Rockets history, and his baseline jumper with 3.1 seconds left gave Houston a 100-98 victory over the Cleveland Cavaliers on Tuesday night. Olajuwon scored 21 points with 12 rebounds, seven blocks and six assists as the Rockets won their third straight game, spoiling Cleveland's regular-season debut at new Gund Arena. Olajuwon's ninth point of the night — a foul shot with 10:32 left in the third quarter — gave him 17,950 in his career, putting him ahead of Calvin Murphy for the top spot in team history. The crowd gave him a standing ovation. But his real heroics were yet to come. The Cavs stormed back from a 14-point deficit in the final six minutes, running off 14 straight points to tie it 94-94 on John Williams' baseline jumper with 1:19 left. Olajuwon stopped that run with a baseline shot. Cleveland tied it again at 98 when Mark Price sank an off-balance 3-pointer with 20 seconds left. Olajuwon, however, took a pass from Sam Cassell on the left baseline, spun and shot a 15-footer over Williams for the winning points with 3.1 seconds left. Price missed a desperate, off-balance 3-pointer at the buzzer. Vernon Maxwell scored 17 and Otis Thorpe had 16 for the Rockets, who still have a long way to go to match last year's record-tying 15-0 start. The Rockets kept the sellout crowd of 20,562 quiet in the early going, taking a 27-12 lead late in the first quarter with a run that featured three 3-pointers, two of them by Robert Horry. Olajuwon had four blocks in the quarter, and Price missed all five of his shots. Price, however, electrified the crowd at the end of the half, scoring five points in the final four seconds to put Cleveland ahead 48-46. He sank a 15-footer with 3.4 seconds remaining in the half then hit a 3-pointer from 27 feet away at the buzzer after Williams deflected the inbounds pass.
