ed to New York," she told the jury.

Pat Smith said she was involved in the contract negotiations while in New York but thought she was helpful in her "ambassador role" she played to represent A&M.

"I was an extension of Robert's efforts to get the deal for A&M," she said.

"Robert does not tell me what goes on at A&M businesswise," she said.

She also said she did not know who paid for the trip until the last few months.

After the defense and prosecution closed their cases, the judge denied DeGuerin's second motion to instruct the jury to acquit Smith of the misdemeanor charge because Turner had failed to produce any evidence that Smith had committed a crime.

The jury will hear closing arguments today at 9 a.m. in the 361st District Court. The jury is expected to reach a verdict this afternoon.

Turner, the Texas Ranger and the FBI began their investigations last year when questions over the Barnes & Noble contract were raised in an anonymous letter sent to Gov. Ann Richards.

If convicted, Smith faces up to one year in jail and a \$3,000 fine.
