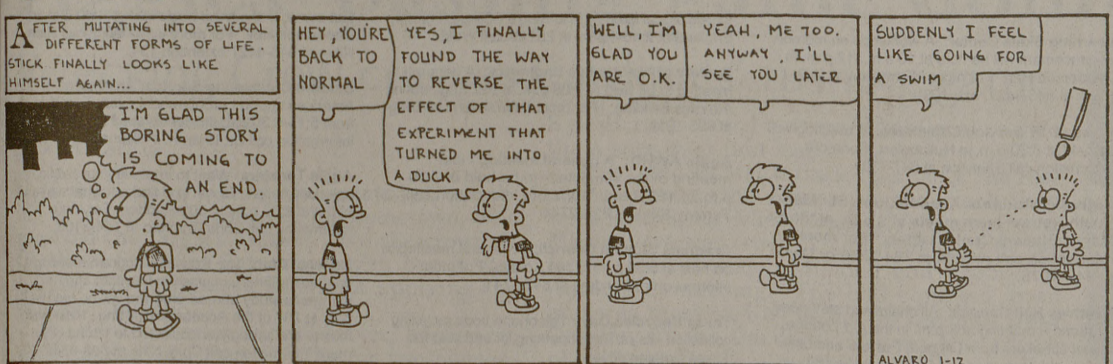

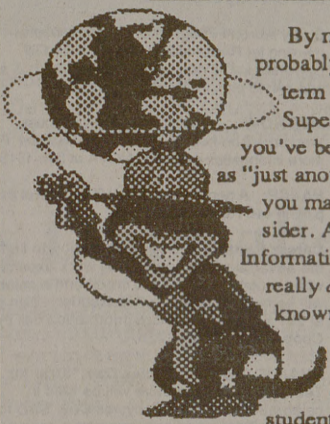

What can I find with Gopher?



By now, you've probably all heard the term "Information Superhighway." If you've been tossing it aside as "just another buzzword," you may wish to reconsider. A form of the Information Superhighway really *does* exist. It's known as the Internet, a worldwide network of computers. As a student, faculty, or staff member at Texas A&M, you have access to an abundance of information on it. Tools such as Gopher and Mosaic make finding information on the Internet as simple as "point-and-click."

There are so many information resources available via the Internet that we could never list them all. However, here is a short list of services that you might find useful. You can find these from the Texas A&M Gopher's Main Menu by looking around under the menu options *Texas A&M University (TAMU) Information* and *Browse Information by Subject*, or by doing Veronica, particular resource, or subject searches.
