A&M runner qualifies for NCAA championships

Despite an overall lackluster performance by the Texas A&M men and women's cross country teams at the NCAA Region VI Championships, senior runner Matt Priest received tremendous news this weekend when it was announced that he had qualified for the NCAA Championships.

Priest finished seventh overall in the men's race, but the team as a whole placed ninth out of 13 teams. The women's team ended up eighth among the 13 competitors.

"Coming out of conference, I knew we had to have a good performance today," Priest said. "Fortunately, I ran well enough to be able to go to the NCAA Championships. It's been a real good season and it's a great feeling to know that all the hard work has paid off for me."

Junior Shannon Etchberger was A&M's top finisher on the women's side, placing 14th, while junior Mary Sangalang placed 19th.

Despite their low placement, A&M coach Greg Hinze was pleased with the women's performance at the meet.

"The women ran great today. They did all they could do and that's all I can ask of them," Hinze said. "All of them ran their personal best today and as a coach, you can't ask for anything more than that. The encouraging thing is that everyone will be back next year and they know what they have to do to get better."

The Texas A&M women's volleyball team proved to be kings of the road this weekend, winning twice on Saturday against Southwest Missouri State and Iowa State to run their season record to 15-11.

In the first game against Iowa State, the Lady Aggies defeated the Lady Cyclones in three straight games, 15-7, 15-2, 15-2. The win was largely due to a stifling defense that held Iowa State to .098, .077 and .115 hitting percentages in the three games. Dana Santleben led all players with 11 kills and also recorded a 400 hitting percentage. Junior setter Suzi Wilentz recorded 28 assists and senior Page White added seven digs.

The Lady Aggies also made short work of SWMSU, sweeping the three games, 15-11, 15-2, 15-11. Senior outside hitter Jennifer Bronner recorded 14 saves and Kristie Smedsrud added 12 in the win. Wente continued her consistent brilliance, recording 41 assists. In the second game, the Lady Aggies enjoyed one of their finest performances of the year, turning in a .750 hitting percentage while cruising to a 15-2 rout.

The Lady Aggies return to action on Tuesday night at home against Southwest Texas State at 7:00 p.m.

Aggie defeats Ford Hood Tankers in exhibition

The Texas A&M men's basketball team started off their exhibition season off right Saturday night, defeating the Ford Hood Tankers 85-64 Saturday night at G. Rollie White Coliseum in front of a crowd of 1,286.

The Aggies shot 50 percent from the field while holding their opposition to a meager 34.9 percent. A&M was led by senior forward Joe Wilbert, who appeared in mid-season form, hitting 10 of 15 shots while racking up 26 points and ten rebounds. Senior guard Tony McGinnis added the Aggies cause with 22 points, six rebounds and four steals in just 30 minutes of play.

Although sophomore guard Jimmy Smith started at the point position, freshman Kyle Kessel continued to impress, racking up seven points and seven assists in 23 minutes of play.

Guard Roderick Hall led Ford Hood with 20 points, although it took him 25 shots to do so. No other Tanker scored more than nine points. The Aggies resume their exhibition schedule tonight when they host the Mexican national team at 7:00 p.m.

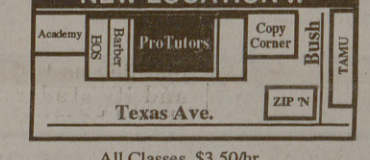
