As far as the history of it goes, I believe that Elephant Walk was started by a group of seniors who realized that school days were about completed and that seniors would soon be facing the "cruel, cruel world." It was built upon the belief that elephants, upon reaching maturity, would leave the pleasures and activities of youth and go off into the jungle and pass away.

The activity was led by a Texas Aggie Band senior (a sousaphone player). Seniors would leave their dormitories and fall into lines behind the sousaphone player.
