

**Dallas** sets sights above NFC East

IRVING (AP) - Three consecutive NFC East championships don't mean much to the Dallas Cowboys.

A third consecutive Super Bowl victory is all that will make them celebrate.

'Winning the NFC East didn't make us jump around," wide receiver Michael Irvin said. "We don't want a pat on the back until we win another Super Bowl. We have to do anything we can to get a third ring. We don't want to look back in 10 years and regret we didn't give it our all."

Dallas beat Philadelphia 31-19 on Sunday to stretch its overall record to 11-2. It was the 16th division championship in club history and gave the Cowboys a 21-6 all-time record in games after Thanksgiving.

"This ain't that special," offensive guard Nate Newton said. "Super Bowls are special."

Safety Darren Woodson, who returned an interception 94 yards for a touchdown to put the Eagles away, said the Cowboys were unemotional after the victory because they had anticipated winning the division.
