TUXTLA GUTIERREZ, Mexico (AP) — New President Ernesto Zedillo said Thursday on his first official visit to Chiapas that he was seeking to promote peace by his presence at the inauguration of a new state governor.

Zedillo's message appeared to be yet another exhortation for Chiapas rebels to resume peace talks with the Mexican government. But rebel commander Marcos warned earlier this week that Robledo's inauguration would shatter an 11-month-old ceasefire that quieted a New Year's uprising.

Zedillo said his week-old administration has a firm commitment to attack the poverty, social injustices and discrimination against ethnic Indian communities that have inspired violence.

The respondents were adult baseball fans from random national poll tak Nov. 30 to Dec. 6 by ICR Su vey Research Group of M dia, Pa., part of AUS Consu tants. Results have an error margin of 4 percent.

While just 19 percent women said they would attend fewer games if replacemen are used, 33 percent of me said they would go to the bal park less often. Nineteen cent of those 65 and old would go to fewer games, 31 percent of those aged 18would attend less often.

Television viewing wou be similar, with 21 percent women and 33 percent men saying they would watch fewer games.

When asked generally abo the possible use of replacen players next spring, 49 per of fans were in favor and percent were opposed. Thir three percent of fans 65-plu oppose replacement players, while 47 percent of those 1834 opposed the concept.


Forty-six percent of thos making \$50,000 or more an opposed, while 38 percent those making less than \$15,00 are against the move.
