

MODEMS update Beginning April 10, CIS will require you to claim

the MODEMS resource through the Access subsystem before you will be allowed to use CIS modems. The conversion process will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Monday and should be completed no later than noon

A guest account will be available for access to the NOTIS and Access subsystems on the MVS (VTAM) system, allowing modem access to these systems without using a specific modern account and password. The resource in Access for the CIS dial-in modems is called MODEMS. You will need to get the MODEMS resource allocated to your Access account.

CIS will require that you claim the MODEMS resource through the Access subsystem for a

number of reasons. First, the security problems with the open access configuration must be addressed. Currently, no way exists to track or prevent anomalous behavior through the CIS modem banks. The addition of PPP (Point-to-Point Protocol) makes the problem even worse. Second, this will allow CIS to gather statistics on who is using this resource. Statistics can then be used to try to increase the funds for support and expansion of CIS modern banks. Finally, this will restrict the use of the campus modems to our authorized customersfaculty, staff, and enrolled students at Texas A&M University.
