Oscar-seeking son looks to overcome Addams family jinx

LOS ANGELES (AP) — The Academy Awards give actor-director Sean Astin a classic chance to follow in his parents' footsteps.

Twenty-six years after actor-director John Astin's "Prelude" was nominated in the short film category, his son's "Kangaroo Court" is up for an Oscar on Monday in the same category.

John Astin, known best for starring as Gomez in TV's "The Addams Family," lost in 1969. His wife and Sean's mother, Patty

Duke, took home the trophy as best supporting actress for 1962's "The Miracle Worker."

"Kangaroo Court" tells the story of a police officer being tried for murder by an inner-city gang. The gang members serve as judge and jury; Gregory Hines plays

hangs out in lounge bars and says, 'Hi, Baby. Have you see 'Schindler's List?'"




