governments assume any kind of power over the media. But we need to recognize that the media has an awesome power."

Despite this responsibility, the panelists said, the media are often the victim of manipulation.

During the war in the Persian Gulf, Begleiter said, both the U.S. and Iraq governments controlled the American news media.

"To this day we don't know how many Iraqi casualties were in the war," Begleiter said. "All we saw were the wonderful pictures from the Pentagon on the smart bombs. We never saw the pictures of the ones that did not hit their targets."

Bozell said the government can overdo regulating the media for security reasons.

"I don't care about how the enemy feels," Bozell said. "But I do care when the government, for national security reasons, does not disclose information. But can the government take this to an extreme? Absolutely."

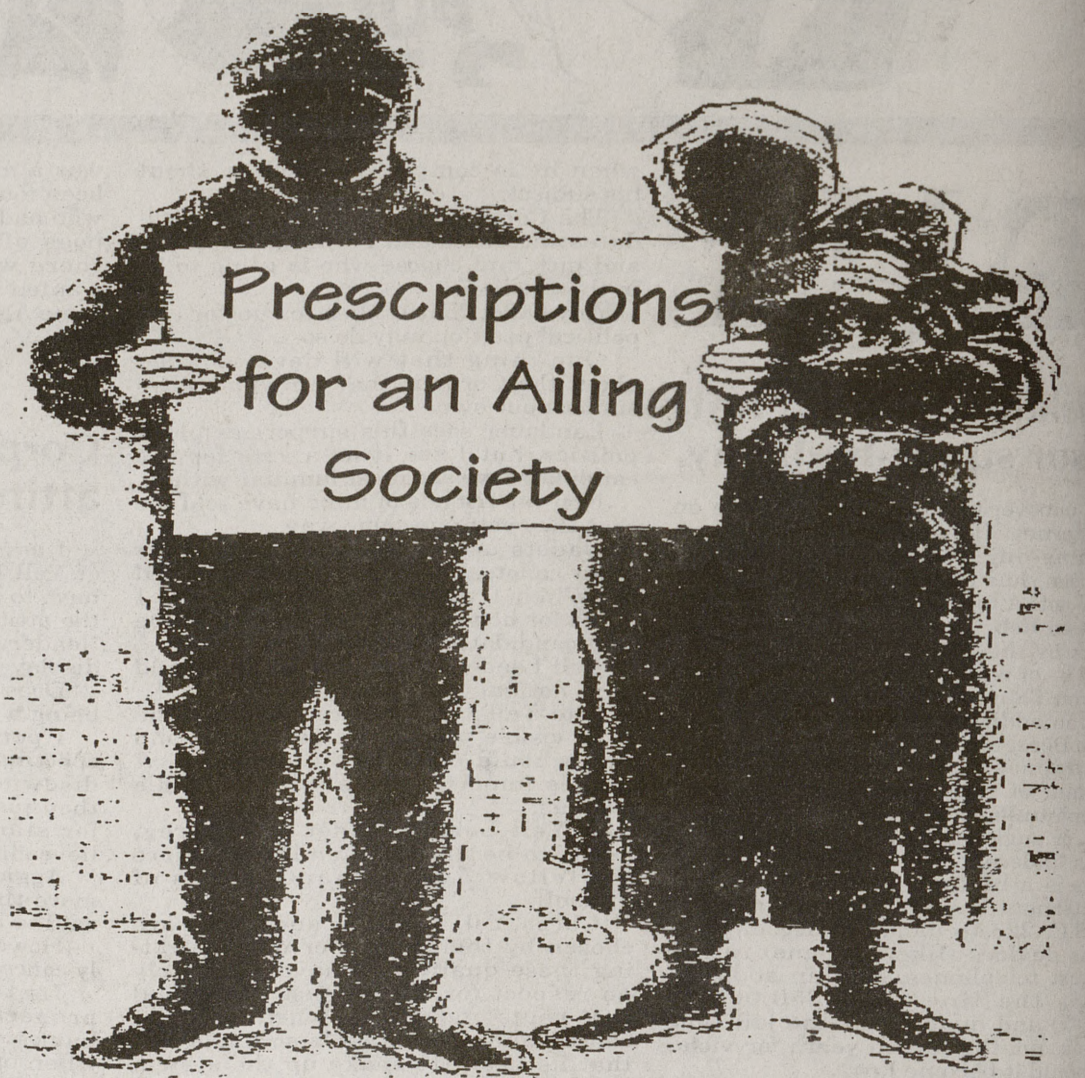
