taught health education from kindergarten through the 12th grade.

She said children spend 15,000 hours during those years watching TV, 11,000 hours on reading, writing and arithmetic and only 44 hours on

health education. Elders said that parents should be educated on how to be better parents, that young men and women should be educated and held responsible

for their actions and that all young people should be given hope. "It is far cheaper to pay for college than to pay for prison," Elders said. "We can't reduce the cost of

health care in America until we begin to prevent some of the problems which we've talked about." Sullivan said the family is the best tool for the education and value formation that is crucial to a

productive and safe society. 'A culture of character begins with family," he "It is the first and best source for value

formation. Homicide, he said, is the leading cause of death

among young black men. Homicide, along with heart disease, strokes, and cancer, is now a major cause of death," Sullivan said. "During every 100 hours on our nation's streets, we lose more young men than were killed in 100 hours in the ground war in the Middle East."

Sullivan said that because of the cultural implications, everyone should be concerned about violence and homicide.

Seven members of the same family have been charged in a string of bank robberies, home invasions and carjackings, said Sgt. Steve Ruteshouser of the Houston Police Department.
