

Mitchell's confidence has steadily grown despite getting hit pretty hard earlier in the season.

"I've gotten pretty lucky lately," Mitchell said. "In the fall gave up four home runs in one outing and the team gave me a pretty hard time about that. I hurts your confidence and it took me about two or three days

to shake it off. Mitchell's biggest accomplishment this season was his win against the University of Houston at the beginning
