HUNTSVILLE (AP) - Former Lubbock District Attorney Alton Griffin believes some people forfeit their right to life and Clarence Lackey is one of them.

There are depraved individuals and I think he is a depraved individual," said Griffin, who first sent Lackey to the Texas death row more than 17 years ago. "I don't see any socially redeeming feature in him that gives him a right to live.'

Lackey, 40, was set for execu-tion early Friday for the 1977 abduction, rape, beating and neardecapitation of 23-year-old Toni Diane Kumpf in Lubbock. A state


