Hurricane Allison heads for Florida

People residing and vacationing on the Gulf Coast prepare for the season's first hurricane.

SHELL POINT, Fla. (AP) — Residents in a flood-prone section of Florida's Panhandle boarded up their homes, fled inland or bought up extra batteries, flashlights and food as the sprawling monster called Hurricane Allison barreled toward their shores.

The first hurricane of the 1995 season moved across the Gulf of Mexico on Sunday and was expected to come ashore before 9 a.m. today.

Allison, packing torrential rains and 75 mph winds, was expected to make landfall near Panama City, according to Lixion Avila of the National Hurricane Center in Miami.

"This one doesn't seem as if it's going to be as strong as some hurricanes have been in the past," Tallahassee real estate agent Errol Stafford said hopefully.

But like hundreds of others, Stafford wasn't taking a chance. He left his vacation home in Shell Point late Sunday with a rental truck load of belongings.

At 5 a.m., Allison's center was near 29.3 north latitude and 85.5 west longitude, about 40 miles

southwest of Apalachicola, a Franklin County town about 50 miles southwest of Tallahassee. The hurricane was moving north at 14 mph, forecasters said.

Hurricane warnings were posted along a stretch of coastline almost 500 miles long — from Anna Maria Key, 18 miles north of Clearwater, to Pensacola.

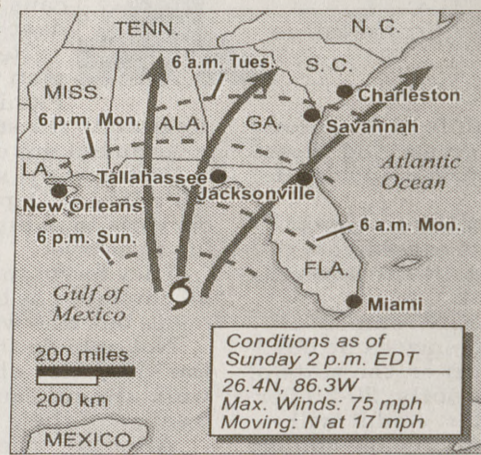
In Southern Georgia, a flash flood watch was issued as forecasters predicted up to 8 inches of rain associated with Allison could fall on a region devastated by flooding 11 months ago.

About 5,000 people were evacuated from coastal regions in the flood-prone Big Bend area, said Carl Petteway, emergency management coordinator in Franklin County.

People were told to evacuate from areas in Franklin, Liberty, Wakulla, Taylor and Jefferson counties — an area stretching along the entire panhandle about halfway down the peninsula.

Many residents quickly boarded up their homes, packed a few belongings and fled the area. Roads away from the coast had heavy traffic; many

vehicles towed boats. If people refuse to leave, "The best our fire department can do is to ask them to wear a body bag so we can identify their body when it's all over," said Morris Smith, emergency management director for Jefferson County.
