drop deadline, but it will be only under extenuating circumstances, which will be determined by the student's dean."

The Senate also recommended approval from Bowen on the following items:

- Adding age, sexual orientation and marital status to the list of illegal discrimina-

tion practices for which a student may file a grievance.

- Establishing three new undergraduate courses: Agronomy 455, Environmental Soil Science; Poultry Science 427, Animal Waste Management; and Maritime Administration 470, Environmental Law.

- Adding English 211, History of Literary Criticism; English 330, Arthurian Literature; and English 339, African-American Literature, to the University's Core Curriculum.

of players, especially in our football and baseball programs, that go on to play professionally. Even though many come back to get their degrees, they're counted as an academic casualty forever."

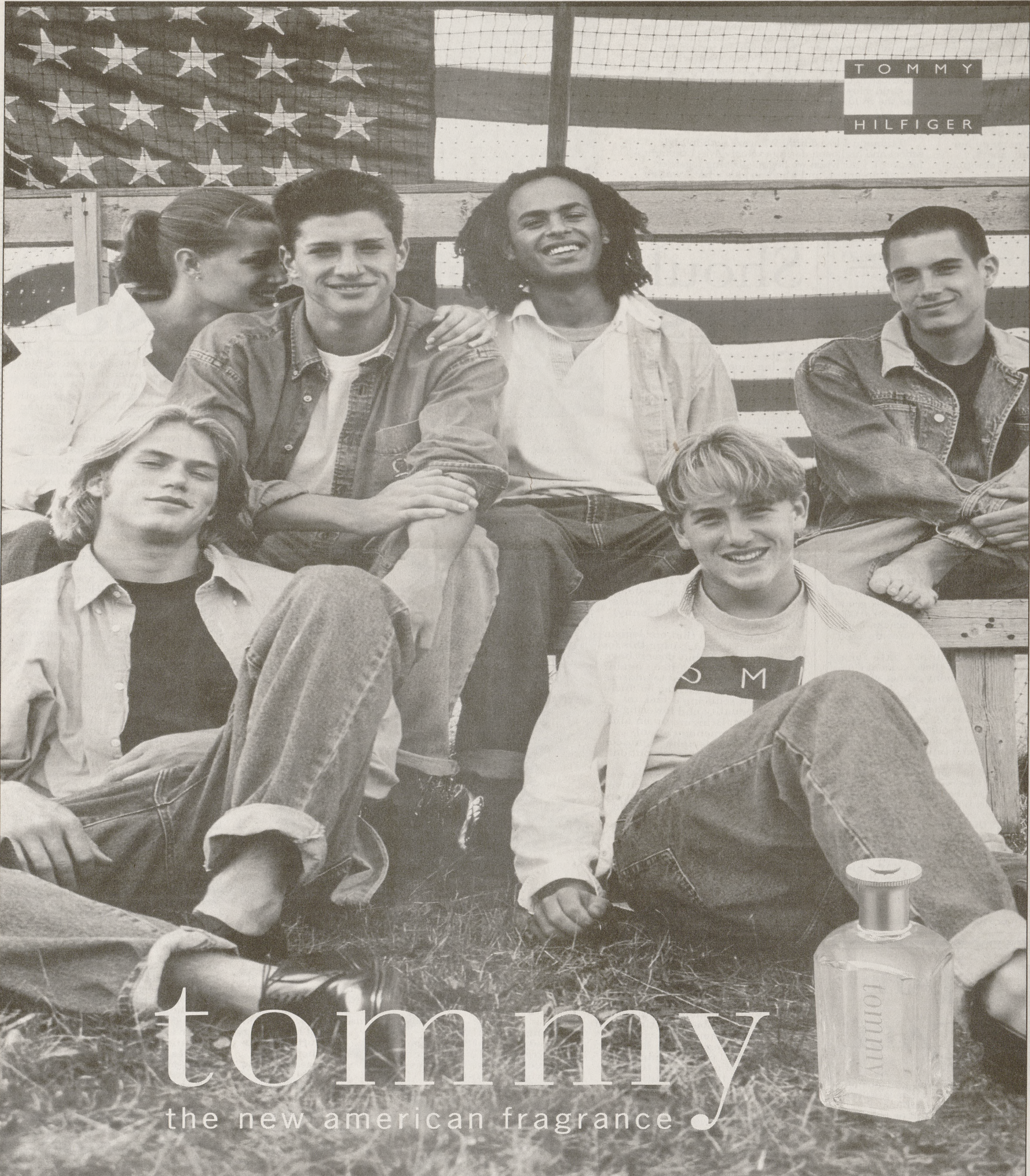
Groff added that the average A&M non-athlete graduates in 4.7 years, while the average A&M athlete graduates in 5.3 years. He also said the Athletic

Department has made moves to improve the graduation rates of minority athletes.

"We're very concerned with this problem," Groff said. "We've added staff for academic counseling for our minority students."


Carreathers said he remembered no complaints or incidents from black athletes concerning A&M's academic programs.

Texas A&M's rates were 10 percent lower than those of the University of Texas, which graduated 49 percent of its athletes enrolled in 1988-1989.
