## Hiroshima ceremony marked by peace appeals

HIROSHIMA, Japan (AP) — With tears and prayers for the dead whose corpses filled the rivers of Hiroshima half a century ago, thousands of people set glowing lanterns afloat Sunday night, capping a day of tributes to victims of the world's first atomic attack. The day began with a ceremony to mark the moment — 8:15 a.m. — when the bomb exploded over Hiroshima on

Aug. 6, 1945, turning the city into an inferno of flame, superheated wind and radioactive dust.

All told, 140,000 people died in the explosion and over the following six months — half Hiroshima's wartime population.

On Sunday, about 50,000 people packed into the city's Peace Park — built on the wasteland left near the center of the blast — to hear appeals for the abolition of nuclear weapons and frank admonitions that Japan must face up to its own wartime aggression.

## Police arrest reputed leader of Cali drug cartel

BOGOTA, Colombia (AP) — Police raided a Cali apartment and caught the reputed boss of the world's biggest drug gang in his underwear Sunday, days after the president's election campaign was accused of taking \$6.1 million from the cartel.

Miguel Rodriguez Orejuela, alleged leader of the Cali cartel, was arrested before dawn along with his ex-wife, a bodyguard, a chauffeur and a maid.

Rodriguez immediately denied traffickers contributed to President Ernesto Samper's 1994 campaign.

Rodriguez is the sixth leader of the Cali cartel to wind up behind bars in two months. The gang is believed to control 80 percent of the world's cocaine market.

ation Storm" took another key rebel-held town Sunday. As Croats celebrated, tens of thousands of Serbs fled in the biggest refugee exodus in the former Yugoslavia in four years of war.

The fall of Petrinja, which came a day after Croatian troops retook the rebels' self-proclaimed capital of Knin, further crushed rebel dreams of establishing a separate Serb state.

Fierce fighting continued across much of the Serb-held region, a crescent-shaped land that hugs northwestern Bosnia, and which Serbs call Krajina.

But the fall of Knin and Petrinja, combined with the capture of the strategic Udbina airfield and signs that the Serb-led Yugoslav army would not intervene, led the Croats to predict quick victory.

## Grand jury may indict McVeigh this week

OKLAHOMA CITY (AP) — The grand jury investigating the Oklahoma City bombing will return three indictments by Friday's deadline, naming Timothy McVeigh, Terry Nichols and

their Army buddy Michael Fortie. McVeigh's lawyer predicted Sunday.

The addition of Fortie, yet another authority say admitted to casing the federal building with McVeigh before the bombing, will be a "sham indictment," complained attorney Stephen Jones.

"That is to say, they've already made a deal and he is being named primarily as an inducement to produce his testimony for the government," Jones said in a telephone interview from his home in Enid.

## Pirates use long ball to down Astros 6-3

PITTSBURGH (AP) — Jay Bell waded in for a home run and a pair of home runs in the eighth inning to lead the Pittsburgh Pirates, who were out of the lead in the seventh, to beat the Houston Astros 6-3 Sunday.

Bell and Houston's Orlando Hernandez homered twice each, but Pirates right-hander Estaban Loaiza (7-5) pitched Hampton for his first victory in five starts since the All-Star break.
