woman of the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services. In addition, Dr. J. M. Southerland, A&M vice president for student affairs, has cited several times, as he has administrators from TRC. Trevor had nothing but things to say about those who have helped him recover, plans to visit all the people who offered their money, prayers and thoughts.

He has a standing appointment to visit the Texas Tech where he will be introduced to the Senate floor. Trevor wants to visit every church prayed for him.

"I want to show them their prayers worked," he said. The final stop on the tour will be the A&M campus. Trevor said he is determined to resume his studies and do better in school than before the accident.

He said he is anxious to get back into the groove of college. Joe Shockley keeps a photo album filled with photographs of his son throughout his recovery and rehabilitation. With the collection of the accident, he said pictures of him while he was in a coma are interesting to see but do not bother him.

In fact, Trevor is quite profound about life after the accident.

"That bus destroyed my bike, but it didn't destroy me," he said.

Arnold said. A nurse practitioner, Megan Brown, was hired to head up a full-time women's health clinic.

The clinic, located on the second floor of Beutel, provides breast and pelvic exams, various forms of contraception, treatment for infections.

Brown said she hopes women will make appointments, but that walk-ins are allowed if there is room in the schedule.

"I hope that we have a lot of patients," she said. "I hope that we expand to eventually get more nurse practitioners on the staff."

Other health center services include immunizations, an allergy clinic, health education, radiology lab and physical therapy.

During regular hours, physicians see patients by appointment before 1:30 p.m. After this time, physicians do walk-in patients. Doctor appointments are free, and prescription medication is provided at a discount.

The inexpensive services provided by the health center are one reason why students say they are unimpressed with the cutback in university care services.

Trey Thomas, a junior industrial distribution major, said he believes urgent care is necessary at a school as big as A&M.

"We are getting 'free-of-death as it is,'" Thomas said. "The financial situation at A&M isn't all that bad. We could find the money somehow."

Leach Schwarz, a senior recreation, park and tourism sciences major, said she can't imagine not having urgent care available.

"If somebody gets hurt, they can't wait until morning," Schwarz said. "But you go off-campus, it's much more expensive and less convenient."

Peter Mes, a freshman mathematics major, said that because many new students are unfamiliar with Bryan-College Station and some do not have a car to get around, it would be a good idea for the health center to be open 24 hours a day.

"I'd rather know the health center is working all the time in case something happens," Mes said.
