

Tax overhaul a group effort, Bush says

AUSTIN (AP) — Gov. George W. Bush says he remains eager to overhaul the state's tax system to lower property taxes. But he says it's bigger than a one-man job. Legislative leaders, lawmakers and

taxpayers must get behind the idea, too, Bush said Thursday.

Blue-ribbon committees have studied the Texas tax system, law-makers have tinkered with it, rates have been raised and tax bases broadened. But state government continues to rely heavily on the sales tax, while schools and local governments lean on property taxes

Texas remains one of the few states without a personal income tax, and Bush said that levy won't even come up for discussion.

U.N. weighs whether to punish rebel Serbs

SARAJEVO, Bosnia-Herzegovina (AP) — The United Nations struggled Tuesday with one of the most deficate decisions in its long Bosnian mission: how to punish rebel Serbs for massacring dozens of Sarajevans without derailing a new U.S. peace initiative.

Sending NATO warplanes or using the new U.N. rapid reaction force to re-taliate for Monday's mortar attack near a crowded Sarajevo marketplace would alienate the Serbs, who must make concessions for any deal to work.

But a weak response to the slaugh-ter of 37 people threatened to send Bosnian government negotiators packing. President Alija Izetbegovic, in Paris for talks with French and U.S. officials, said he was "under pressure by Bosnian public opinion to withdraw' his negotiators.
