## Astros sweep Expos

The win keeps Houston 1 1/2 games behind LA in the wildcard race.

MONTREAL (AP) — Doug Drabek came off a suspension Sunday and pitched seven strong innings to lead the Houston Astros to a 5-3 victory over the Montreal Expos. The win gave the Astros a sweep of the three-game series against the Expos, who continue their season-long stumble.

Houston finished 6-3 on a nine-game road trip and stayed in second place in the wild card standings, 1 1/2 games behind Los Angeles.

Drabek (10-8), who sat out five games for hitting Cincinnati's Benito Santiago with a pitch on Sept. 5, gave up three

runs on six hits and struck out five for his third straight victory.

Mike Henneman pitched the ninth for his sixth save, sending Montreal to its 10th loss in 13 games. Henneman has saved six games in seven opportunities since being acquired from the Detroit Tigers in exchange for third baseman Phil Nevin last month.

The Astros have won 11 of their last 18 games after losing a club-record 11 straight.

The Astros batted around the fourth against Pedro Martinez (13-9), a rally highlighted by Ricky Gutierrez's two-run single, to take a 4-1 lead.

Houston was unable to gain any ground on the Dodgers however, as Los Angeles crushed the St. Louis Cardinals 8-0.

It is possible that the year could end with three undefeated teams, but only FSU and Nebraska playing for a championship.

If he wants to lead his team to a national championship, Slocum needs to follow up on the initiative of FSU's Bobby Bowden and Nebraska's Tom Osborne and start hitting opponents with everything in the Aggies' arsenal.

Granted, Slocum does not any one of the big guns — like Corey Pullig and Leeland McElroy — to get injured, but A&M's second team contains plenty of guys who can break big plays.

Slocum said he puts in the second and third-string guys because they have earned the right to get into the game. It seems if they want to get into the game, they'd also like to score some points instead of just running out the clock so as not to hurt the other team's feelings.

Why can't Kevin Colon test his arm and a young receiver on a deep post route? Why can't the offense run the same screen to Tiki Hardean as they do to Leeland McElroy? Two or three more scores Saturday, and it might be A&M hot on Nebraska's heels instead of Florida hot on the Aggies'.

Maybe it's poor sportsmanship to run up the score, but think of it as a mean that justifies the end, namely a championship.

Now, as the University of Houston knows well, beating the crap out of teams can come back to haunt you. But the Cougars always ran the score in ridiculous fashion, staying with the first team until the bitter end, allowing quarterbacks Andre Ware and David Klingler to rewrite the Southwest Conference and NCAA record books. Hapless teams including Eastern Washington and Louisiana Tech were UH's victims.

Embarrassing other schools and individual honors are not the Aggies' motives this year. UH never had a shot for a national championship during the run-and-rosk years until 1991.

That year they found that they were not on the level they thought, as first Miami and then Illinois blasted the Cougars on the road, exacting revenge for UH's victims from previous years.

The Aggies' situation is completely different, and opponents who complain need to wake up and smell the desert air of Tempe, Ariz.

It is calling to the Aggies, and they need to respond with big numbers. Otherwise, the national championship dream will remain just that.
