"When you go back two weeks ago to the quarterback scramble he ran for about 20 or 30 yards, that was a big play, a significant play in that game at that time," Slocum said. "You can go back and analyze and look at all those plays that he has made that have really enabled us to be successful

Despite his success, Pullig refuses to take personal credit for his individual accomplishments.

"I've been fortunate to play on good teams," Pullig said. "I've stayed healthy and could not have done it without the guys around me. It's a team effort, not an individual one.
