
# Tough road ahead Frie for A&M soccer

After defeating Texas Christian 3-1 in the Southwest Conference opener on Monday, the Texas A&M soccer team hits the road to take part in this weekend's UMass Classic.

Taking their 4-2 season record into tournament action, the Aggies, ranked 19th in the country, will square off against the 11th-ranked University of Massachusetts Minutewomen today at 2 p.m., and will wrap up tournament action on Sunday at noon against the Lady Wildcats

of New Hamp shire.

Recognized as one of the nation's top programs, Massachusetts

brings a tradition of excellence into this week-

end's tournament. The Minutewomen notched their 250th victory as a program this past Sunday in a 1-0 victory over George Mason and have compiled an impressive overall record of 250-59-22 in 18 years of play.

Massachusetts' record at home is even more staggering. The Minutewomen sport an incredible 101-12-8 record on their home turf, outscoring their opponents 344 to 49.

Texas A&M Head Coach G. Guerrieri looks forward to the challenge of putting his young squad on the same field with a program as successful as Massachusetts.
