European team grabs Ryder Cup

ROCHESTER, N.Y. (AP) — The European team stunned the United States by taking singles matches Sunday to win the Ryder Cup for the first time since 1987.

Leading 9-7 going into the final day, it seemed like a lock the United States. It had been outscored in singles since 1985, the year Europe won its breakthrough victory in the Ryder Cup.

But when Philip Walton, 10th and last man to qualify the European team, put within tap-in distance at No. 2 to win his match against Haas 1-up, Europe had 14 points and the Cup.

Phil Mickelson defeated Ulrik Johansson in the final match of the day, making the final score 14 1/2-13 1/2.

The U.S. team needed to win only five of the 12 singles matches Sunday to keep the Cup. But only Mickelson, Lehman, Davis Love and Pavin could do it. Fred Couples got a half-point for halving a match with Ian Woosnam.

The European team got victories from Howard Clark and Mark James, then came big in the middle of its lineup. David Gilford, Colin Montgomerie, Nick Faldo and Steve Torrance — playing in matches six through nine — defeated Brad Faxon, Ben Crenshaw, Curtis Strange and Larry Roberts, respectively.

The victory gave Europe the Cup for the first time since 1989. It won in 1985 by defeating the Americans in Sunday singles play by the same 7 1/2 score it did Sunday at the Hill Country Club.

The Europeans won again in 1987 and kept the Cup with a tie in 1989 before losing the next two. The United States now leads the series 23-6 with two ties. But since the '85 victory by Europe, it is 3-2-1 in favor of Europe.

"What a fantastic win," Woosnam said. "It just shows that the strength of golf in Europe is getting bigger and bigger all the time."

Astros top Cards, 1-0

HOUSTON (AP) — Mike Thompson scored on pitcher Rich DeLucia's throwing error in the 10th inning, and the Houston Astros stayed alive in the wild-card chase Sunday with a 1-0 victory over the St. Louis Cardinals.

The Astros began the day 1 1/2 games behind Los Angeles in the race for the playoff spot. The Dodgers, trying to catch Colorado in the NL West, opened a three-game series with the Rockies on Monday.

After starters Mike Hampton of Houston and Donnovan Osborne of the Cardinals matched zeroes late into the game, the bullpen decided it.

Thompson, a pinch-hitter, walked with one out in the 10th. Brian Hunter followed with a dribbler to the right side of the mound that DeLucia (8-7).

DeLucia looked toward Thompson, then threw wild to first base. Thompson scored on the play, which was scored as a hit for Hunter and an error on DeLucia.

Dean Hartgraves (2-0), pitching for the first time since recovering from food poisoning, got the final out in the 10th for the victory.

Hampton pitched eight innings. He allowed six hits, one walk and struck out seven.

Osborne gave up three hits in seven innings. He walked two and struck out four.

Hampton allowed a runner to reach third base in each of the first two innings, giving up four hits. He permitted only two hits thereafter.

Osborne escaped a bases-loaded jam in the third, and after Hunter flied out and Craig Biggio struck out, Jeff Bagwell and Mike Simms walked. Osborne retired Tony Eusebio on a full-count grounder to end the inning.

Osborne retired the next 12 batters before leaving for a pinch-hitter.

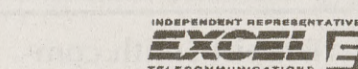

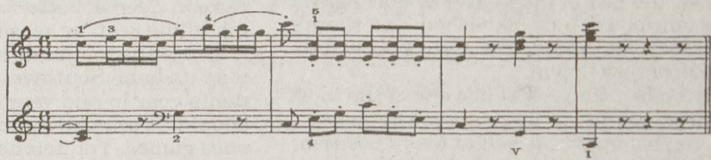
