Sunflower, a five-member, guitar-oriented band from Austin, will be performing at The Tap Saturday. The band is part of The Tap's effort to bring more original bands to College Station, John Whittington, general manager of The Tap, said.

"We are trying to change the proportions of cover music and original music," he said. "We have to spoon feed original music to students. They aren't used to it."

Whittington said Sunflower is a high-energy band that has got-

ten a good response from the crowds at The Tap.

"They make their own rules as they go," he said. "They don't give the audience a break. They grab the crowd and don't let go of them."

Peter Raspler, the band's manager, said the band has a modern sound and sings positive lyrics.

"They aren't like raw, in-your-face moshing," he said. "They are having a good time and are riding out a groove."

Whittington said the band stuns the audience into acceptance, and it has been the most requested band to be brought back to The Tap.

Heath Clark, a guitarist with Sunflower, said the music is unique and modern sound.

"It's melodic," he said. "It's a groove to it."

Clark said the crowds at the band's shows are usually enthusiastic.

"You get to express the music live to people you've never seen before," he said. "It gives us a chance to show what we've got and to turn people on to the music." Sunflower has been together for two and a-half years and is originally from Beaumont. The band will follow the release of its debut album *New Territory* with *Round Trip* in October.
